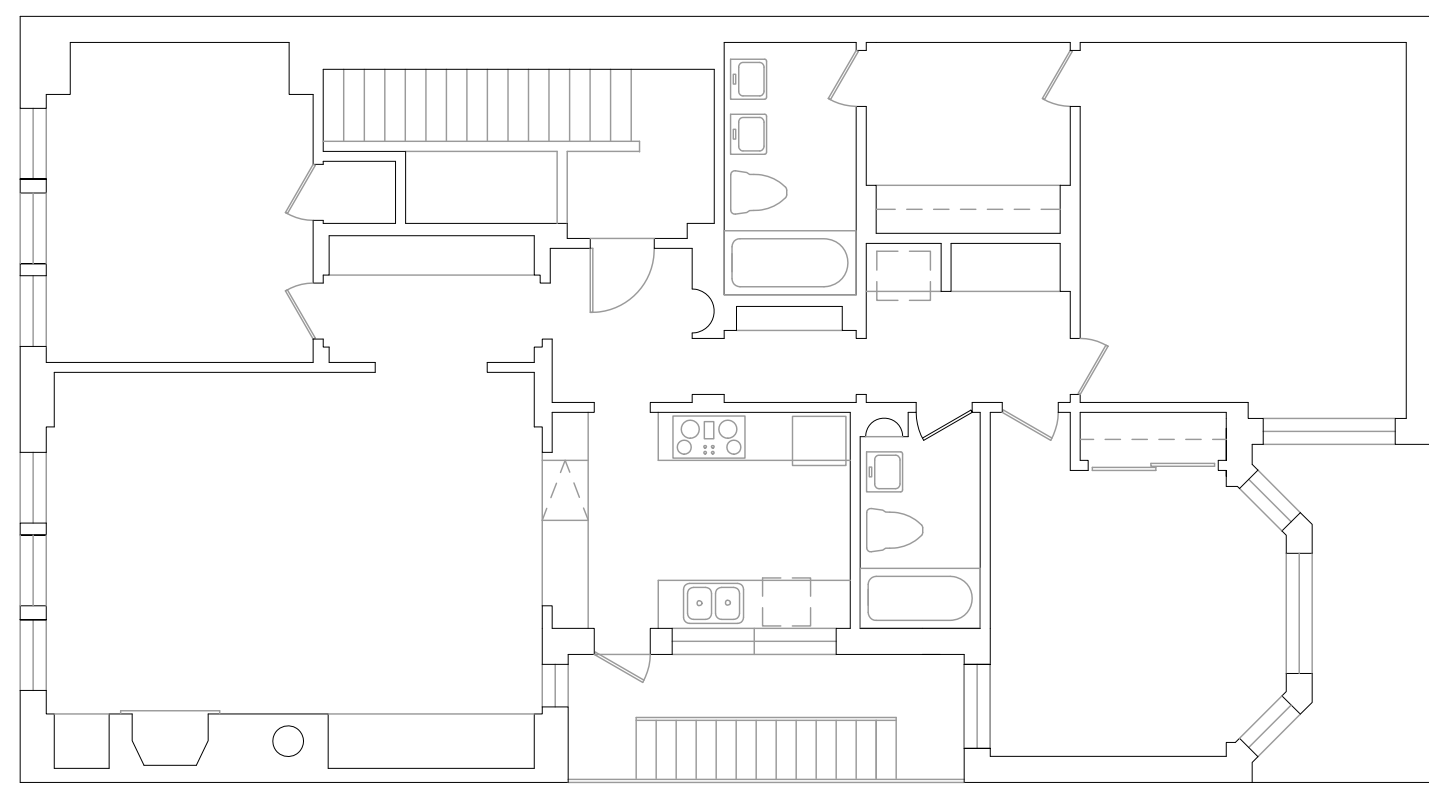
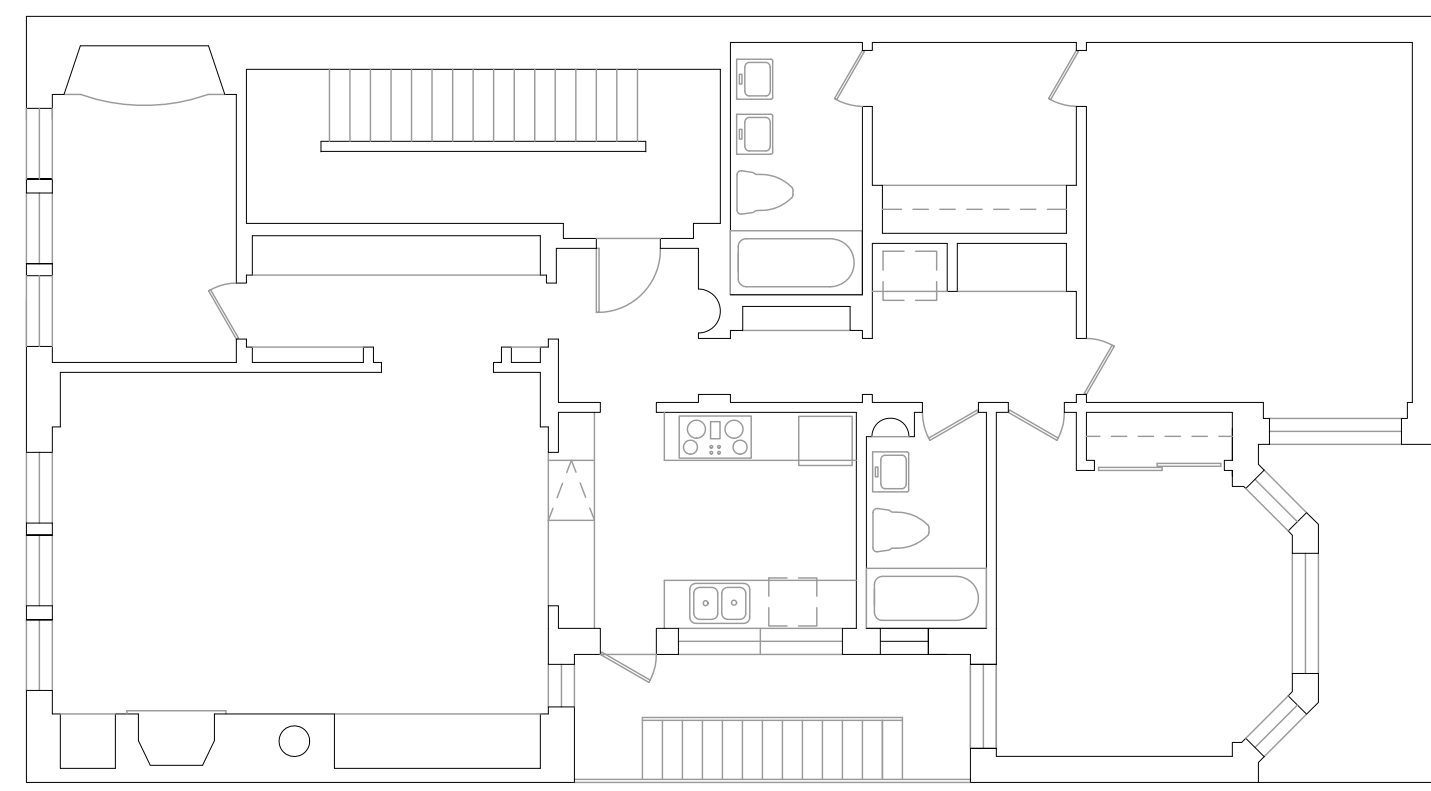


JONES STREET CONDOMINIUMS,  
SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA

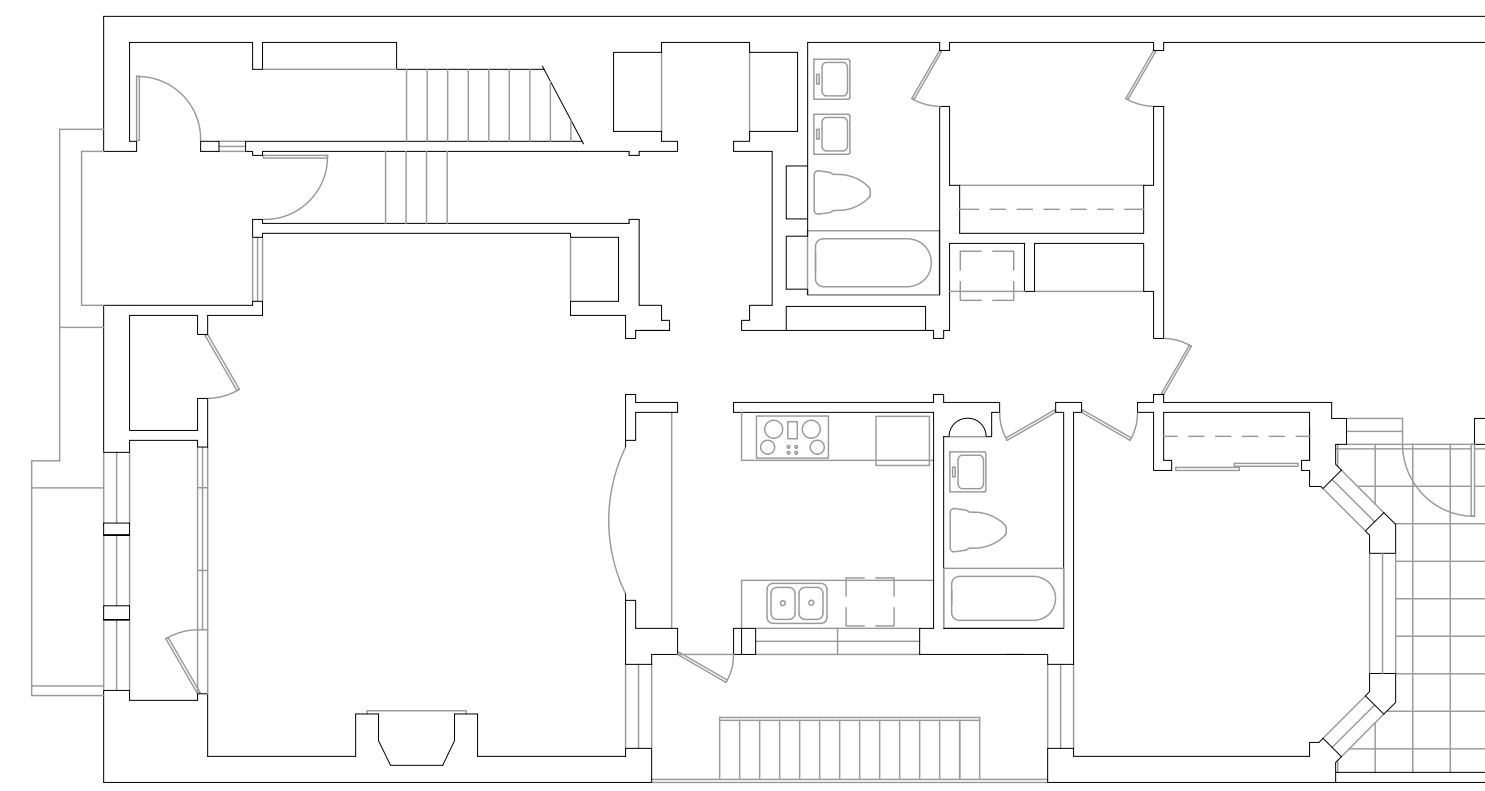
Located on Lower Nob Hill in the heart of San Francisco, this Victorian (Gothic Revival) remodeling project includes three two-bedroom condominiums with a new three car basement garage. Originally built at the turn of the twentieth century as a single family townhouse, the design completely reorganized the interior so that each apartment is arranged on one level and accessible from a common entrance foyer and stair hall. Project completed in 2009.



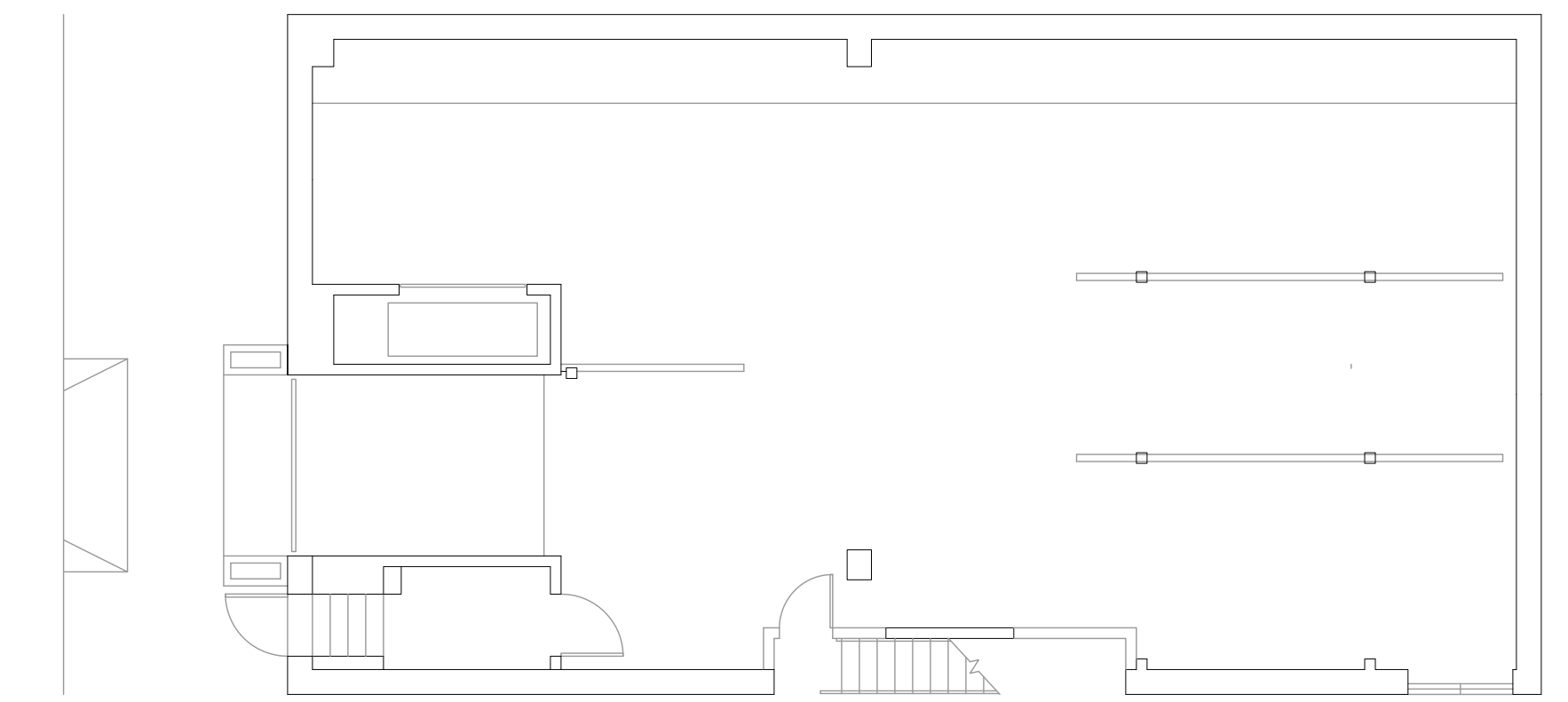
THIRD FLOOR



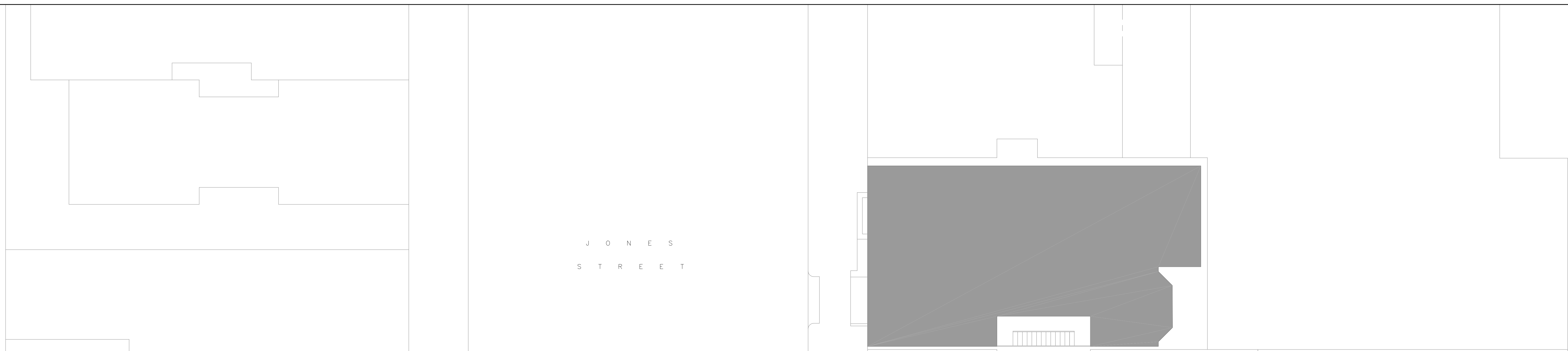
SECOND FLOOR



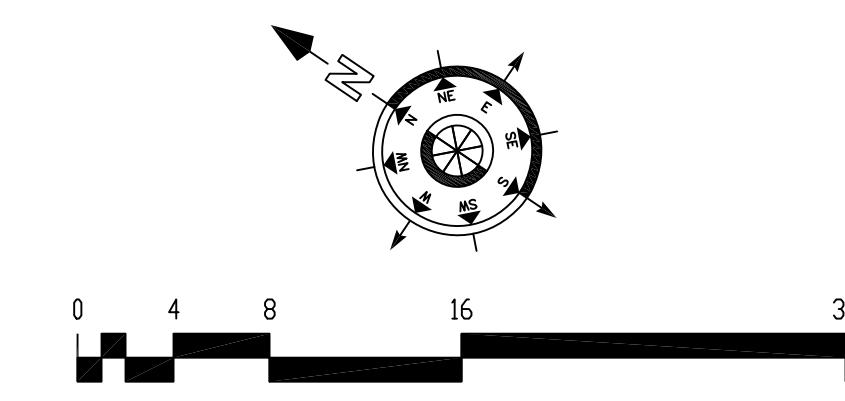
